### Profile Summary

Jonathan Corbitt has been an active member of the gymnastics community since 1980 during his days as a young athlete. He won numerous state and regional titles as a junior gymnast and earned a scholarship to join the men's gymnastics team at the University of Illinois in 1994. As their team Captain, he led the Fighting Illini to a 3rd Place Team finish at the 1998 NCAA Championships and was ranked in the Top 5 nationally on numerous events throughout his collegiate career. Mr. Corbitt also achieved Academic All-America designation each year as a student-athlete.

After his athletic career at the University of Illinois, Mr. Corbitt achieved Category 1 status as an international FIG Brevet men's judge and currently serves as the Vice President of International Programs at the National Gymnastics Judges Association (NGJA). He is also a current member of the Pan American Gymnastics Union Men's Technical Committee (PAGU MTC), overseeing the Pommel Horse apparatus. In elite USA domestic competitions, he has served as a National Apparatus Leader (NAL) multiple times, judging the USA Championships fifteen times in addition to four U.S. Men's Olympic Trials (2008 – 2020). Mr. Corbitt has several international competitions to his credit, including the inaugural 2010 Youth Olympic Games in Singapore, the Junior and Senior Pan American Games, and the World Championships (7x), most notably as the D1 on the Floor Exercise at the 2014 World Championships in Nanning, China. Mr. Corbitt was presented with the FIG Gold Award for Longevity of Judging Service in at the Stuttgart World Championships 2019.

Mr. Corbitt has regularly served as an expert technical and judging consultant for the USA Men's Artistic Gymnastics National Team coaching staff, and he has aided in the athlete development of several World and Olympic medalists during his time at National Team camps and technical clinics at the U.S. Olympic Training Center. Mr. Corbitt has also completed the FIG Academy Level 3 course for coaching excellence.
